- Measure 9: E1 (finger 5), D1 (finger 5), C1 (finger 5), B0 (finger 5), A0 (finger 5).

Chord changes are indicated above the staff: C (above measure 1), Dm (above measure 2), G7 (above measure 3), C (above measure 4), E7 (above measure 6), Dm (above measure 7), D (above measure 7), C (above measure 7), D7 (above measure 8), G7 (above measure 8), and C (above measure 8).
